Mr. Cathell reported a bill, entitled an act to make valid a certain deed therein mentioned;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Seidenstricker,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by Mr. Frazier, chairman of the committee on divorces, entitled an act to divorce Susan E. Etherington from her husband, John Etherington;

The said bill was then read the second time and passed.

Mr. Boyle reported a bill, entitled an act to confirm and make valid the proceedings of the Trustees of the First Presbyterian Church of Carroll county, and for other purposes;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Stull, entitled an act to incorporate the United Seminary in Carroll county; and

The bill reported by Mr. Causin, chairman of the committee on corporations, entitled an act to incorporate the New Windsor Library company;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, and passed.
