Gentlemen of the Senate :

We herewith return the bill, entitled an act supplemental to an act, entitled an act respecting the equity jurisdiction of county courts, as requested by your honorable body.

The bill from the Senate, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act to amend the Constitution and Form of Government, so far as relates to the division of Allegany county into election districts, and to establish an additional election district,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The resolution directing the Librarian to furnish the clerk and register of wills of Allegany county with copies of index to the laws, was taken up for consideration, read the second time and assented to.

The bill reported by Mr. Forman, entitled an additional supplement to the act, entitled an act to incorporate the Buckingham Academy, in Worcester county, passed at December session 1813, ch. 13, was taken up for consideration, read the second time, and passed.

Mr. Sprigg of Allegany, obtained leave to introduce a bill, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act passed at December session 1839, entitled an act in aid of the building of an academy in the town of Frostburg, and a market house and town hall over it, in Cumberland, Allegany county;

Ordered, That Messrs. Sprigg of Allegany, Coombs and Thayer report the same.

On motion of Mr. Sprigg of Allegany,

The house adjourned until Monday morning ten o'clock.
