

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled an act supplemental to the act, passed at December session 1832, chapter 70, entitled an act to lay out and open a road in Cecil county; also

The bill entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil county, to levy a sum of money to rebuild a bridge over Octorara creek, in Cecil county, passed at December session, 1838, chapter 200; also

The bill entitled a supplement to an act entitled an act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil county, to levy a sum of money to repair a bridge over Octorara creek in Cecil county, passed December session 1838, chapter 255;

Severally endorsed "will pass" and the bills severally ordered to be engrossed; also

The bill entitled an act to extend the time of Thomas Baldwin, late sheriff of Prince George's county, for collecting his fees;

Endorsed "will pass" with the proposed amendments," which amendments were severally read the first and by a special order the second time, severally assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed; also

The bill entitled an act for the benefit of Jacob Shimberger, of Baltimore county;

Endorsed, "will not pass;"

And delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled a supplement to the act entitled an act for the relief of the crier, jurymen and bailiffs of Cecil county, passed at December session 1839, chapter 69;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Maxwell, Welch of Kent, and Tuck;

And a communication from the Treasurer of the Western Shore, containing the annual report of the Managers of the Washington Monument,

Endorsed, "referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates,"

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

The house then proceeded to consider the order of the day being the bill reported by Mr. Bowie, entitled an act to direct the manner in which the agents to represent the State, in all joint stock companies in which the State has an interest, shall hereafter be appointed;

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

Said bill was postponed until to-morrow.

The Speaker laid before the house reports from the clerks of Somerset and Cecil counties, relative to the attendance of the judges;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Also, a report from the clerk of Somerset county, relative to the severals sums of money paid by him into the Eastern Shore Treasury, within the year ending on the 30th of November;
