

Leave was granted the committee on corporations, to bring in a bill to be entitled a further supplement to the act, entitled an act to incorporate the Marine Insurance Company.

Mr. Estep obtained leave to introduce a bill entitled an act to confirm the proceedings of the commissioners of Primary Schools of Howard District, in Anne Arndel county; in altering the school districts in said Howard District;

Ordered, That Messrs. Estep, Gantt, and Dorsey, report the same.

On motion of Mr. E. A. Lynch,

Leave was granted the committee on grievances and courts of justice to bring in a bill, supplementary to the act, entitled an act for enlarging the power of the High Court of Chancery; and also to an act, entitled an act respecting the equity jurisdiction of the county courts;

Mr. Le Grand, from the committee on corporations, reported a bill, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Potomac Steam Packet Company, passed at December session 1828, ch. 183;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Jones of Somerset, nominated for the Branch Bank of the
