So the bill was passed and sent to the Senate.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill, entitled an act providing for the payment of the cost of certain alterations in Baltimore county court-rooms;

Also the bill, entitled an act for the relief of David Greeves and Cornelius Ryan, of the city of Baltimore, and for other purposes;

Also the bill, entitled an act to repeal the act passed December session 1835, ch. 201, establishing magistrates' courts in the several counties of this State, so far as the same relates to Prince George's county;

And the bill, entitled an act for the benefit of Zachariah Sunder-

land, of Calvert county;

Severally endorsed, 'will pass," and the bills severally ordered to be engrossed.
