Also, the bill, entitled an act to authorise George H. Steuart, administrator de bonis non of Caleb Batson, to manumit the negroes therein mentioned;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to reduce the compensation of judges

and clerks of elections in Frederick county;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to repair injuries done on the Baltimore and Su-quehanna Rail Road;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to incorporate the Annapolis and

Chesapeake Steam Navigation Company;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to regulate the drawing of lotteries in this State;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to alter and amend the constitution, so far as it relates to the loaning of the public money or credit, to corporations;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to provide for the appointment of an

agricultural chemist for the State of Maryland;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to abolish magistrate's courts within this State, and to extend the jurisdiction of single justices in certain cases;

Also, the bill, entitled an act providing for the repeal of the fifty-

ninth article of the constitution;

Also, the bill, reported by Mr. Graves, entitled an act for the better regulation of the banking institutions of this State;

Also, the bill, reported by Mr. Willis, entitled an act for the bet-

ter regulation of the banking institutions of this State;

Also, the bill, entitled an act to provide for the reorganization of the city court of Baltimore, and for the more prompt administration of justice in said city;

Also, the bill, entitled an act supplementary to an act, entitled an act for the prevention of frauds on the right of voting by the stockholders in the several incorporate institutions in this State, passed at December session 1836, ch. 264;

And the bill, entitled an act relative to the banking institutions of the State of Maryland;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, and severally referred to the consideration of the next General Assembly of Maryland.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled an act for the payment of the journal of accounts;

Endorsed, "will pass," and ordered to be engrossed.
