

Also the bill, entitled a supplement to the act passed December session 1836, ch. 144, entitled an act for keeping in repair the public roads in Prince George's county;

Also the bill, entitled an act to lay out and open a road in Cecil county;

Also the bill, entitled an act to authorise the levy court of Prince George's county to levy a sum of money for the use of Thomas Grimes;

And the bill, entitled a further supplement to the act to incorporate the Upper Marlborough Academy, passed at December session 1835, ch. 204;

A bill, entitled an act for the relief of the securities of Israel Mayberry, late collector of the taxes for Allegany county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Sprigg of Al., Coombs and Thayer.

And a bill, entitled an act to alter the constitution of Maryland, so far as the same relates to election districts in the city of Baltimore, and for repealing an act, entitled an act relating to election districts in the city of Baltimore;

Which was read and referred to the committee on the constitution.

Mr. E. A. Lynch, from the select committee, made a favorable report on the bill from the senate, entitled an act to empower the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to sell the market house in west Patrick street, and apply the proceeds to the erection of public pumps in Bentz town, in Frederick: passed at December session 1838, chapter 1;
