

## FIVE O'CLOCK, P. M.

The house met.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled a supplement to an act to improve and keep in order the streets in and roads near the town of St. Michael's, in Talbot county, passed at December session 1817, ch. 176;

Endorsed "will pass," and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill, entitled an act to authorise William B. Paca, to build a bridge;

Endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments."

Which amendments were severally read the first and by a special order the second time, severally assented to and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill, entitled an act for the relief of Grove Shipley and Reuben Connoway, of Carroll county;

Endorsed "will not pass."

Also, the resolution in favor of John McDowell Goldsborough;

Endorsed, "dissented from."

And, delivered the following bills originated in and passed by the senate, viz:

A bill, entitled an act relating to the levy court of Queen Anne's county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. George, Ford and Paca.

A bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act to unite Middletown, Keller's addition to Middletown and Wise's addition to Middletown, into one, and incorporate the same;

Which was read and referred to the committee on corporations.

And, a bill, entitled an act to make valid a deed from Charles H. Bland, of Baltimore county, to Helena Stewart, of the city of Baltimore;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. Estep reported a bill, entitled a further supplement to an act passed at December session 1828, chapter 21, entitled an act to abolish the levy court of Anne Arundel county, and for other purposes.

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

Mr. Lecompte submitted the following message, which was read, assented to with the bill therein mentioned, and sent to the senate.

*By the House of Delegates,*

April 1, 1841.

*Gentlemen of the Senate:*

We herewith return to you the bill, entitled "an act for the relief of Grove Shipley and Reuben Connoway, of Carroll county," rejected by your Honorable body on the 31st ult., and respectfully request that you would reconsider and pass the same.
