The Condition of which Recognizance is such that if the above
bound Christopher Foster & Joes Banister, do make their
Personall appearance at our next County Court to be hold the
second Tuesday in January next then & shew to answer unto such
matters & things as shall be objected aet them on behalf
of his Maties that then this obligation to be void and of none
effect otherwise to be & remaine in full force & Virtue.
