John Viner Justice of the Peace to the Sheriff of Somerset County
Greetings. Sheweth in his Majesty's name to charge and
Command that he take into his custody the body of John Janner late of
said County taken by Thomas Cox & Henry Shaws by Verdict of the Jury
for suspicion of Duggery &c. that he safely keep the said John Janner in
his safe custody until the next County Court to be hold at Doding Wood
second Tuesday of the instant Year, or till he shall be liberated by our
Courts of his Majesty's Laws, & for doing this shall be in sufficient warrant
given under my hand Seal the second day of December in the 2 year of
his Majesty's reign Anno Domini 1695. John Viner

to Thomas Cox, and Henry Shaws were answered by strictly charged command
to be the said Prisoner to the said Sheriff.

The aforesaid Warrant being read it was by the Court ordered that if
the said John Janner give good security for his app in next Court to answer for
his response and the said John Janner & his servants Stephen Collins &
Thomas Cox and the said Janner do acknowledge him self to be indebted
unto our Sovereign Lord the King the sum of one hundred pounds sterling
to the said Stephen Collins in the sum of fifty pounds sterling money a piece all
due to be levied on their goods Chattels Lands & Tenements for the
Matters up &c.

The Cause of which Recognizance is due that if the above bound John
do make his personal appearance before the Justice of our next County Court
to be hold at Doding Wood the second Tuesday of Month next then shall
he answer unto all such matters & things as shall be then & there objected a
gainst him on behalf of our Sovereign Lord the King his heirs & Recognizance to
be void or else to remain in full power force & Virtue.
