Writ in the third of the Grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King & Defender of the Faith etc. to the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we command you that you take Jm Taylor if he shall be found in your County & shall keep so that you have his body before the Justice of our County Court to be holden at the bidding of the Lord on Tuesday of Grant to answer what shall be objected against him on behalf of our Sovereign Lord the King heretofore and at your special Command & there the Writ with Francis Jonckins Esq. Chief Justice of our County Court the 19th day of October in the 4th year of our Sovereign Lord James Dominus 1695.

The Defendant being by Recognizance bound to app. this day appeared. Therein was read the following Judgment viz

Somerset County etc. The Grand Jury for the County of this County, on their Oath do propose Christopher Foster for that he doth Christopher not having the fear of God before his eyes but moved by the instigation of the devil hate & hatred with one God Banister and with her hate committed fornication contrary to the Peace & Act of the Parliament in that behalf provided. Sent the Court.

The Judgment being read with their former Examination & the Court judgment is that he is guilty & for want of good security for the King's Service the Court awarded Corporall punishment viz to do Christopher 15 floggs lasted on his bare back well laid on which he was bound as of old etc.
