

The Ralph to answer to our Sovereign Lord the King the said that said Mary give security for her in this Order, according to del of assembly the Writ upon Anne de Mary with her security Richard Thimblett, and the said Mary & Richard do by way of Recognizance, acknowledge them selves to our Obedience with our Sovereign Lord King William the third the sum of one thousand pounds of lawful money ready and to be paid on their goods & Chattels Land & Tenements for the matter up & down.

The Condition of which Recognizance is such that if the said Mary Philipott do well & truly pay unto our said Sovereign Lord the just sum of four hundred pounds of lawful money with all Officers fees & disbursements the said Ralph Thimblett at our next County Court to be hold at Dedding Essex the 2. Tuesday of June next then the Recognizance to be void & otherwise.

By his Excellency Cap^{ty} Gen^l a Proclamation

Whereas divers complaints have at sundry times been made unto me by severall Masters & Commanders of Shippes, how that their Affairs and Souldiers are frequently enticed & led away for Pennsylvania and other adjacent Colonies, and also run themselves into many intemperances through means of ^{persons} entertaining them and receiving them into their houses at all times and times, whereby is occasioned not only very great neglect & much loss & damage to the Masters & Owners of such Shippes but also exceeding detriment to his Majesty's Royall Navy & Honour of such Souldiers so enticed and led away forswearing for England, besides publick reflection and scandal which may be brought upon the Government for the same if not timely prevented. To remedy these evils (for the future) such an apparent & growing evil, I have thought fitt, to publish make known and Order, that I do hereby accordingly proclaim and Command, that no person whatsoever Military or Civil within this Province having a Plantation or other wife keeping house, do hereafter any wayes entertain harbour or receive into his her or their house or houses any Officer or Officers, Souldier or Souldiers belonging to any Shipp or other Vessel trading within this Province, unless such Officer or Officers, Souldier or Souldiers shall produce a good Certificate pass from under my hand or the hand and Seal of the Master of such Shipp or Vessel to whom they belong, wherein shall be expressed the Masters real Name or Names, and that when they be no longer detained or kept or entertained the business they are sent upon shall require, under penalty of the party or parties found offending contrary to the true intent and meaning of this Proclamation, being proceeded agt according to the utmost severity of the Law. And I do hereby likewise Notify
