 being read & the same proved. Attachment was made by
 7 p'ts attorney which by the Court was granted to 7 p'ts
 proceed for with Cud etc. the p'ts giving security according
 to Law.

Whereupon came the foredctd & their security Sam Worthington & Cud
 & Stephen James jointly & severally did bind themselves in the
 sum of five hundred of tobacco a piece to the sd Taylor for 7 if the Taylor
 did within a twelvemonth a day come either by law or
 otherwise to appear to the Original action etc. & plead in bar thereof
 that they would be responsible etc. as 7 law requires etc.

Donnick Dennis & Alexandr Macknamie of County Mer. was attached to answer
 unto Donnick Dennis of 7 same
 County Pleasur of a plea of Trespass unto him 7 just sum of one hundred
 only four pounds of tobacco which from him he unjustly did demand
 did whereupon the sd Donnick by Sam Worthington their dttor in law Comr @
 he that whereof the sd Alexander on 7 25th day of April in the year of
 Lord God 1691. at Muffwadore within the Jurisdiction of the Court
 came indebted unto the sd Donnick in the just sum of one thousand
 only four pounds of tobacco in Cash to be paid at or before 7 tenth day of
 October next ensuing the date of the said Bill, which date is the day @
 aforesd. Notwithstanding the said Alexander to the sd Donnick 7 Tobacco according
 to the said Bill hath not paid but hath by Cud refused to do
 at damage of the sd Donnick of two thousand forty eight pounds.
