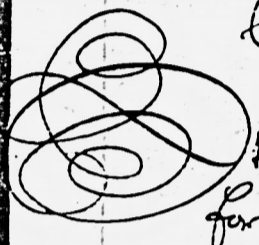


Mary Hills had 12th day of 7th mo 1695 made: Oath in Court that she
