her self & to the said John Cornish faithfully promises that she y^e
said Berthonia would well & cheerly the said 1855 Pounds of tobacco
would well & cheerly Content & pay the whole of the said Berthonia y^e
the said sum of tobacco to the said John Cornish while she was sole &
