The said being was to bring the said peace not guilty of for-
 cyall put her self on i Country - Whereupon Command was given
 to the Sheriff to bring hore such good & lawfull Men of the County
 that the matter in hand might be the better understood, as left or named
 whose of us returned as followeth (viz) Edward Green, Geo. Goddard, Fra
 boyes, James Langwell, James Bennett, Wm Lawsons, Geo. Smith
 Wm Crowe, Adam Heatch, Archibald Smith, John Elizabeth & Co. Aug. 12
 who being duly summonsd returned Sworn upon y holy Evangelists
 having heard y said default proceedings recite their charges as last
 forke. On the day so with the day after the same Jury are being returned
 to the Bar in Court being each called are all agreed of their Verdict to
 the effect being as wife calls, the Verdict is read as followeth. (viz)
 That the said Jury find that Anne Lye is guilty according to the Bill of Indictment
 Edward Green foreman.

Where Verdict aforesaid Court ordered to be entered, and further ordered that
 the said Anne Lye pay four shillings & six pence to the said Edward Green
 for her habeas corpus. Court's opinion is that the said Anne Lye is to be
 committed. Whereupon Anne the said Anne Lye is bound in her own
 and the said Anne die acknowledge her self to be indebted into our
 Lord the King the sum of six pounds Sterling money & be satisfied
 in the sum of three pounds like money and all due to be satisfied on
 her good & lawful Land & Tenements for this in King's High Court.

The Jurors of whose Recognizance is here that if the said Anne
 die of the good to be had in the said Water the said Right
 of the Province during the Court's pleasure & pay off of the
 that she has obligation to be void of laws & all other ways to be
 & remain in full power force & Virtue.
