This Bill entitling me James Jones of Somerset County to pay  
or cause to be paid to Joseph Light two Throre or offyngs & just  
sum of two thousand & 1000 Lbs of merchantable tobacco & Cigars  
to be paid convenient in Pocomoke River in October next for  
performance bound. I Swear by my hand and  
Seal the 26<sup>th</sup> of May 1695. James E Jones.

The Original Writ being returned to the defendant the  
Declaration & Bill being read, the Court being satisfied with  
the Verity of the Bill, the Defendant humbly stated and declared agt  
the goods & cōf of the Dſt with Cſt & ſc. Ord' granted for the same  
for the Dſt declared with Cſt, giving Security according to Law  
Whereupon came the Plaintiff & Fra Joyce & did & recog'ning same in  
Open Court acknowledged the same to be indebted to the Dſt  
in the sum of four thousand pounds of tobacco with Condition  
that if the Abſt Dſt do appear to the Original action &  
placed in Barr of the same or otherwys discont' the same or any part  
that Conting will be responsible as per law in such case does require

Dinah Ruthhead, widow of S. Maries County born  
of Wm Ruthhead was attached to answer  
into Court of Somerset County of a place of treason on the 2d day
