

And whereupon the said Francis of himself complains that whereas the said Richard the day of in the year of our Lord 1688 at Doonagh within the Jurisdiction of the Court was indebted in his life time to the said Francis in the sum of Eight hundred & five pounds of tobacco as a particular and thereof there in Court to be produced may appear, and the said Richard to the said Francis in manner aforesaid did assume upon himself, and to the said Francis faithfully promise that the said Richard the sum of Eight hundred & five pounds of tobacco to the said Francis would well and truly content & pay thereunto the said Richard in his life time his promise and assumption aforesaid not regarding but intending fraudulently into doing him the said Francis in his behalf to do & defraud of the said sum of 805 of tobacco in his life time nor the said Cap^t Arnolds Elzy nor John Pantlodon & aforesaid to the said Francis have not paid, but hath hitherto refused, & do still refuse to the damage of the said Francis of Eight hundred pounds of tobacco & thereof his heirs this duty & aforesaid.

Ordered that the sheriff & C^l of each respective County Court within this Province take a constant acc^t in writing of the hour the Court sits & of the hour when they break up, during the whole time of the said Courts sitting, and for to express and remark therein whether all the Justices be sitting, do actually continue sitting those hours, & and so ad and taken (after every Court sitting) are by the said Office to be sworn to before some Magistrate & returned to his Ex^{cy} at y^e Port of Annapolis from time to time
