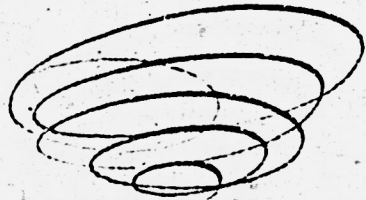


The said Sarah Rockett being destitute of friends and never married doth bind & put her self an apprentice and servant to the said Richard Hunt to serve him or his assignee in the Plantation of Maryland beyond the Sea for the space of four years not ensuing the arrival of the said Sarah Rockett in the said Plantation ~~of Maryland~~ and doth hereby Covenant well and truly to serve the said Richard Hunt, or his lawfull assignee in the said Plantation for during the said term according to the known & Customs of the said Plantation, and doth further declare Covenant that she the said Sarah Rockett at the time of the aforesaid binding herself is the age of twenty one year & a single person and unmarried & no Covenant or Contracted servant to any other person or persons. And the said Richard Hunt for himself his Executors & Assignees. In Consideration thereof doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Sarah Rockett that the said Richard Hunt or his Assignees shall & will at his or their own proper cost & Charge with what convenient speed they may carry & convey or cause to be Carried & Conveyed over unto the said Plantation the said Sarah Rockett & from thence forth and during the said voyage and also during the said term, and at the end thereof shall and will at the like cost and Charge provide for and allow the said Sarah Rockett all necessary clothes, Meate, drink, Washing, lodging & other necessaries fitt and convenient for her according to the Custom of the said Plantation & other servants in such Cases are usually provided for and allowed.
