Richard Chambers of this County was attached to answer unto Wm Faulstett Esq. of Samuel Comblinson, of a plea that he read or unto him One feather bed & covering one Cow, one pewter dish & basin, one brass kettle and brass candle stick & a peck of Indian Corn, which from him he may justly demand & so And whereupon the said William by T. B. Dunt his Attorney complained that whereas the said William the 10th day of January in the year of our Lord 1695. at Menistau within y^e Jurisdiction of this Court was possessed of the several goods & Chattels above expressed being formerly y^e proper goods & Chattels of Sam Comblinson decd of the Value of two thousand two hundred & forty pounds of tobacco which said goods after wards he the hands & possession of the said Richard Chambers. Nevertheless the said Richard well knowing the said goods to be the goods of the said Samuel in his life time, & knew the proper goods of the said William by Virtue of his descent on the goods Chattels & Credits of the said Samuel, but invidiously & fraudulently intended him the said William in this behalf to deceive and defraud the said goods to the said William though often requested hath not delivered.
