 Cooper, me my Heirs Executors & assigns to pay or cause to be paid unto Henry Phillips of the County
 of Frederick him his Heirs or assigns the full & just sum of four hundred pounds of good
 sound Merchantable tobacco & Cash Contingent in the County at or before the tenth day of
 November that shall happen in the year of our Lord 1695. to the true performance thereof
 I Henry Phillips my hand & fixed my Seal this 12th day of June 1694
