 in the just sum of five hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable leaf tobacco & Castles Morishly
 the said John the aforesaid sum of tobacco to the said Graves hath not paid to the great damage of the
 said Graves, of One thousand pounds of tobacco, and thereupon bring this Bill into Court.

 demand, to the which payment well & truly to be paid I bind my self my Heirs or assigns in
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written.

The Declaration & Bill being read in the Court of the County of Somerset for the said John Parliamore in open Court Confess
 judgment for 500 pounds of tobacco, which this Court grants order for to be paid to the said Graves or his Heirs or assigns.

 To the Grand Jurors of our Sovereign Lord the King for the County of Somerset
 County the second Tuesday in November Just now on their
 Oath do present John Chancellor & Marie his Wife of
 this County for one hog being the proper hog of Walter Brand of this County of the value
 of one hundred pounds of Pork, then and there being the same did feloniously take
 steal and carry away contrary to the Peace of the said County.

The Indictment being read to which the said John Chancellor Confess himself guilty whereupon
 the Court did order that a Jury notwithstanding his Confession should be sworn by the matter aforesaid
 whereof is returned as followeth. (viz) Robt. Syner, John Barne, John Morris, Wm Matthews
 Peter Dickson, Man Morris, Adam Spence, Tho. Davis, Wm Guekin, Griffin Thomas, Tho
 Gordon, Jameson Allen. who having heard the said Indictment read & Confession of the party
 return their charge & are sent forth the said day makes return of their Verdict as followeth
 We find for the King & judge the hog to weigh forty pound. Whereupon the Verdict was read
 to be entered & ordered four fold with Cost / Corperall punishment remitted.
