unto her the full and just sum of four hundred pounds of good Merchants l^o bawc & Casts which to her he oweth &c. And whereupon the said Katherine by Peter Doul her Attorney saith that whereas the said William the 22th day of July in the year of our Lord 1695 at Accomack, within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his Certain Bill Obligatory which the said Katherine with the Seal of the said William signed brought here into Court & date whereof is the day & year afo^e, at &c. owed &c. him self to be justly indebted to the said Katherine in the said full & just sum of four hundred pounds of good sound Merchants l^o bawc to be paid to the said Katherine at or before the last day of October next ensuing the date of the said Bill. Nevertheless the said William the said sum of 400 Pounds & l^o bawc to the said Katherine hath not yet, but the same hath refused and doth still refuse to the damage of the said Katherine of 800 pounds of l^o bawc, and thereof she brings her Sub^a &c.

And Bill Com^o the said Wm Bradshaw of Somerset County Waterman in his Honor or Assignee to pay unto Katherine Tully of this County afo^e or to her Honor or Assignee if full and just sum of four hundred pounds of good sound Merchants l^o bawc with Casts to be paid at or before the last day of October next ensuing & date thereof at Witness my hand this 22th of July 1695 // *Wm M Bradshaw*
