Richard Warren late of this County was summoned to answer unto the sum of Two thousand seven hundred & Eighty pounds of tobacco which to him he owes and my right & claim. And whereupon the said William by his Solicitor his Attorney General did return that whereas the said Richard the 30th day of July in the year of our Lord 1696 at Somerset the in the Jurisdiction of this Court by his Certain Bond in Writing which the said William is the seal with the seal of the said Richard signed brings her into Court the date whereof is the day and year aforesaid, at which time himself to be indebted to the said Wm in the said sum of 2716 Pounds of tobacco to be paid to the said Wm his Heirs Executors & Assigns, to which payment well and truly to be made and done the said Richard bound himself for the whole & in the whole firmly by the Bond or Writing. Nevertheless the said Richard the said sum of tobacco hath not paid to the damage of the said Wm, of four thousand pounds of tobacco & more of his being his debt.

Done at the Court of the said County the 12th day of July 1696.

And the said Richard bound and defends the force & effect of the hearing of the said Bond and it is read unto him, he prayed also the hearing the Condition of the said Bond & it is read unto him in these words: The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Richard Warren shall appear at the County Court held for this County the second Tuesday in August next at Dorchester or there to make payment of the sum of one thousand three hundred fifty eight pounds of tobacco, a certain debt & charged, on an Execution bearing date the 12th day of July anno Domini 1696 payable to Wm Grover of this County & shall save keep harmless & indemnified the said Whittington & him from all troubles & in commitments which shall or may accrue thereby. Then this Obligation to be void & of none effect or else to remain abiding in full force & power & Virtue.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden Richard Warren shall appear at the County Court held for this County the second Tuesday in August next at Dorchester or there to make payment or give security for the payment of the sum of one thousand three hundred fifty eight pounds of Tobacco a certain debt and charged on an Execution bearing date the 12th day of July anno Domini 1696 payable to Wm Grover of this County & shall save keep harmless and indemnified the said Whittington of and from all troubles and

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
