John Walton late of this County was summoned to answer unto

William Allen of a Debt that he owed or might owe

Cow and four Calves, which he owed and my self

testified // And whereupon the said William by Edward Jones his Attorney Complaineth that the said John the 27th day of December in the year of our Lord 1694 at Dorchester within the Jurisdiction of this Court became indebted to the said William by his Certain Bond Obligatory which the said William with the Seal of the said John signed brought here into Court the date whereof is the day and year aforesaid acknowledged himself to be bound to the said William in the said sum of four Cows and four Calves by their Deeds not to be under four year and also above seven to be paid to the said William his Heirs Executors or Assigns upon demand Now the said John the Cows and aforesaid to the said William hath not paid but hath put the same to still doth deny to the damage of the said William of 7000 pounds of Tobacco & the cost of bringing this Suits Jones & Quer. // Pledges the said John Do. Rich^d Do.

And the said John Cured and Defends the force and injury & prays the hearing of the said Bond & it is read unto him, he prays also the hearing the Condition of the said Obligation & it is read in these words. The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above mentioned William Allen hath this day past his Obligation under his hand and Seal to the said John Walton for four Cows and Calves for the Consideration of One hundred acre of Land, adjoining to the Land of William Jones bought also from the said John Walton. if the said John the above bound John Walton his Heirs Executors shall well and lawfully make over or Cause to be made over unto the said William Allen his Heirs Executors or Assigns by a good firm Conveyance according to Law an undivided right of inheritance of and to the aforesaid one hundred Acre of Land at or before the first day of October in the year of our Lord God 1695. without fraud or further delay, then this obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise to stand & remaine & be in full force power & Virtue //
