Ca. do: present Charles Faussett, for that he & Charles take Coumled & adultery with one Elizabeth Osburn, and with her hath begotten a Bastard Child contrary to the Statute and act the Act of Assembly in that behalf made & provided. / Don't the present

The Indictment being read to which the said Faussett pleaded not guilty: Whereupon it was ordered by the W^{or} Court that six knowing Women be summoned to enquire into the guilt, it being greatly suspected the charge brought against Faussett to be unjust, and thereupon the Sheriff in obedience to the Order returned the six following good women, who were likewise sworn to enquire &c. And this day (viz) the day after the second day of March (viz) Lydia Quillain, Jane Williams, Mary Virgin, Margaret Cary, Patience Atkinson Elizabeth Merrill made Return as followeth (viz) Who being summoned & sworn to enquire concerning the time of Elizabeth Osburn going with Child. Do: find that the said Elizabeth could not conceive with Child at the time by her mentioned, I go to the time of her delivery - Lydia Quillain

Which return of the Women aforesaid by the W^{or} Court accepted & read. Whereupon it was then ordered that the said Faussett be cleared & set at liberty from the said Bastard Child to him laid by & aff. Eliz. Osburn & further ordered that Elizabeth Osburn give security for her good behaviour & good actions in this Case. Whereupon came the said Elizabeth Osburn two Securites Thomas Bromby & Robert Jarvis, and the said Elizabeth did acknowledge her self to owe & be indebted unto our Sovereign Lord the King the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money & the said Securites in the sum of twenty five pounds a piece like money and all due to be levied on their goods & Chattle lands & Tenements for the Matie use &c.

The Condition of which Recognizance is such that if the above bounden Elizabeth Osburn be of the good behaviour & demeanour to all the Matie high People of this Province during this Court's pleasure and also pay all Officers fees in this Case expended that then this Recognizance to be void, of none effect otherwise to be & remain in full power force & Virtue. am. am. am. am. am.

Contained at some one Town or Port in the aforesaid County, at or upon the 10. day of October next ensuing the date hereof ad Witness my hand & seal this 28th day of May anno 1689
