Know all Men by these presents that I John Wallon late of Somerset County Planter and
 firmly bound unto William Allen of the same County in the Province of Maryland Planter in
 full & just Number of Ten good sufficient Merchantable Cows with their Calves by their
 not to be under the age of four years each or above the age of seven years each and to be paid to
 the said William Allen his Heirs Executors or Assigns upon demand, to which payment well and
 truly to be made. I bind myself my Heirs Executors or Assigns firmly by these presents. In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the twenty seventh day of September Anno 1693
 Dominion 1694.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that whereas the above mentioned William Allen
 hath this day past his Obligation under his hand and seal to the said John Wallon for five
 Cows & Calves for the Consideration of One hundred Acres of Land adjoining to the Land
 of William Jones bought also from the said John Wallon. If therefore the above bound John
 Wallon his Heirs Executors or Assigns shall well and truly make over or cause to be made over
 unto the said William Allen his Heirs Executors or Assigns by a good & firm Conveyance
 (according to Law) an undivided Right of Inheritance of and to the aforementioned
 One hundred Acres of Land at or before the first day of October in the year of our Lord God
 One thousand six hundred ninety & five. Without fraud or further delay. Then this Obligation
 to be void & of no effect, otherwise to stand remaine & be, in full force power & Virtue.

 Whereupon came the said Attorney and Edward Jones and Ed Peter Boul and by Recognizance
 both became bound in open Court in Doubts the Debt due for the Defendant &c. That if the
 Defendant should appear the said Plaintiff they would be answerable &c. according to the
 of the matter in such cases on Attachment &c.
