and my to the honor of the said Bill hath not paid to the damage of the said Francis
of seven hundred pounds of tobacco, and thereupon he brings this into the said Court

This Bill binds me Robert Blader of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland
Sawyer my Heir Executors and Heirs to pay or cause to be paid unto Francis
four times of the aforesaid County goods, his Heir Executors or Assigns the full just
sum of eight hundred fifty one pounds of good sound Merchantable leaf Tobacco
to be contained in the aforesaid County at or upon the tenth day of September next
the date hereof as Witness my hand and seal this 21st day of August 1695

The said Declaration of the Bill being read the Defendant in open Court did Confess
judgment for eight hundred fifty one pounds of tobacco according to Bill & Declaration
The Court grants order for the same as is directed with the alias Execution

The Court adjourned till tomorrow at 8 a Clock

Merchantable tobacco & Cask to be paid to the said Samuel in some convenient place
in Annapolis or River to the water paym^t well and truly to be made & done the said
