Present in Francis Goult, in Thomas Dixon, in George Layfield, in Thomas Newbold, in Edmund Howard, in Thomas Goult. The Court's adjourned for half an hour. The Court met & sat again. Present in Francis Goult, in the Dixon, in Matt Scarbrough, in Edmund Howard and then adjourned the Court till tomorrow morning at eight a Clock.

At a Court held for the County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland by the Master Justice of the Peace for the laying & assessing the said County Levy p^o 25th Jan 1696. Present in Francis Goult, in the Dixon, in Matt Scarbrough, in Thomas Newbold and Edmund Howard, in Thomas

ORDERED by the Worth Court that if the Sheriff do not find out four supernumerary taxable persons in this County, that the Sheriff shall be next year allowed for so much out the next years Levy.

This day the above County Levy was by the Justice aforesaid laid & assessed. There being 1388 taxable persons found, which at 53 pounds of tobacco each did amount to 73504 pounds of tobacco. for which in sum the Worth Court did Order the County to issue for the said persons taxable at or above of value to defray the County Charge of 73584. The Court is adjourned till the second Tuesday in January next at 8 a Clock.
