 said Bond never to fail the said John the said 1000 pounds of lob^r to the d^e William hath not paid
 to the damage of the d^e William of 2000 pounds of Tobacco and loss of his bringe his full tra.

 also the hearing the condition of the said Bond and it is read to him in these words. Mary Land
 Know all men by these presents that we Lemuel Loughkill and Thomas Hemmick and John Powell
 of Somerset County in the Province of Connaught and firmly bound into Mary Whittington of
 the same County Sheriffs in the penal sum of one thousand pounds of good sound merchantable
 Sea & Land in Cork to be paid to the said Wm Whittington his heirs Executors or assigns to the
 which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves jointly & severally for the
 whole and in the whole and either of our heirs Executors and assigns firmly by these presents sealed
 with our Seals and dated this 10th day of February in the eight year of the Reign of our Sovereign
 Lord King William annexed Day 1695

The condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Lemuel Loughkill doth and shall make
 his appearance before the Justices of the a^d County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the second
 day of March next to answer into what shall be objected against him in a plea of our
 Sovereign Lord King then this obligation to be void or else to be in full force & virtue tra
 signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us

Upon the back of the d^e Bond was writ
 June y^e 1696
 I assigne the within Bond to our Sovereign Lord the King with my hand Wm Whittington Sheriff
 And the d^e d^e in his proper person comes into Court and confesseth the Debt in the Declaration above
 mentioned to be just and true & therefore it is considered by the Court here that our Sovereign Lord
 the King doth recover against the d^e d^e and well the sum of one thousand pounds of good sound
 merchantable Sea & Land the Debt in the Declaration mentioned as also the sum of
 pounds of Tobacco for his cost of suit in this behalf laid out
 and expended and the d^e d^e in money

Sam^l Whittington J^r of Somerset County was summoned to answer into May
 John Henry Ex^r of the last will and testament of Mr Peter Bodkin dec^d
 was summoned to answer into Sam^l Whittington of a Plea of Trespass of y^e Effect
 And whereupon the said Sam^l in propria Persona comes and saith the said Peter in his life time on y^e
