John Mc Coler and Elizabeth his Wife and Ursula Whittington Dowd of the Goods Chattels and Credits of Andrew Whittington Dec: of a p'tea of Debt & whereupon the said William Hauser & Co. brought their attorney Complainth that the said Archibald on the 13th day of June in y^e year of our Lord 1692 at Locomodel within the Jurisdiction of this Court by a Deed under the hand & Seal of the said Archibald bore and subscribed unto the said Andrew in his life time in the full sum of Eight hundred pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco in Casks never the less the said Archibald according to the tenor of the said Deed the afo^o to the said Andrew in his life time hath not paid nor to the said William and Dowd & Co. nor to any of them since the Decease of the said Andrew to the Damage of the said William and Dowd of Sixteen hundred pounds of afo^o to Casks & thereupon they bring this Suit Whittington & of Plea & John Doe & Ruth Roe.

Two Bill binds it me Archibald Holmes of Somerset County my hand Excuse. I am to pay or cause
to be paid to Andrew Whittington of the County aforesaid the sum or sums or lawful attorney
the just sum or quantity of Eight hundred pound of good sound merchandise to be in Cash to be
paid Convenient according to act of assembly as witness my hand & Seal this 13th day of June 1692
