hath not paid, nor either of them to the damage of the said John of fourteen hundred thirty pounds  
of tobacco and whereupon he brings his suit tra Worthington of Reg: tra John Dod Richard Rod

And the Defendant in his proper person comes into Court and confesseth the Debt in the Declaration afo  
mentioned to be just and true, therefore it is considered by the Court that the said John McNeill plt recover  
as well against the Deft as well the sum of seven hundred fifteen pounds of good Merchandise  
Tobacco in the Declaration mentioned as also the sum of two hundred thirty seven  
pounds of tobacco for his Cost of suit in his behalf laid out Expended and the Defendant in Meru

truly Content and pay, Nevertheless the said Robert his promise and assumption afo not regarding but  
minding and fraudulently intending the said John in his behalf to deceive and defraud the same to the  
said John hath not paid to the damage of the said John of two hundred of tobacco and whereupon he brings  
his suit tra Dent of Reg: tra John Dod Richard Rod
