Be it known unto all by these presents that we Robert Pirrie Edward Green Lodowick Fleming
Richard Tull all of the County of Somerset in the Province aforesaid and justly stand indebted
unto Wm Whittington Sheriff of the County aforesaid in the penal sum of seven thousand pounds of good
tobacco to be paid to the said Wm Whittington his heirs &c. and jointly &c. in the County aforesaid
which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves our heirs Executors and Admin^{rs}
and every of them jointly and severally for and in the whole firmly by these presents and have thereunto
affixed our hands &c. the 13th day of June Anno dⁿⁱ 1696

Whereas the above Bounden Robert Pirrie was lately taken in Execution for the satisfaction of a certain debt
and charges on his suit the by m^r John West Clerk of the County Court and then the said Pirrie together
with the above mentioned Edward Green did enter into a Bond as well to save keep harmless &c. indemnified
the said William Whittington of and from all troubles and Incumbrances which to him might accrue
for or by his said Pirrie having his liberty as also for his appearance at a Court held the second Tuesday
of January Instant at the dividing Court when and where it was supposed the said Pirrie would give
Security to the said West for his said debt and charges expressed in the said Execution or make payment
thereof which not being performed

The Condition of this above Obligation is such that if the above Bounden Robert Pirrie his heirs &c. and
Admin^{rs} shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John West his heirs Executors &c.
the full sum expressed in and according to the said Execution with all costs upon the same by any
manner of waite or mortgage whatsoever or shall from time to time and at all times save keep
harmless and indemnified him the said Whittington of and from all and all manner of troubles
Incumbrances or any manner of damage which shall or may accrue to him the said William
Whittington his heirs Executors &c. for or by reason of this said Execution or any manner of charges
or cost Incident to or upon the same according to the true intent and meaning of these presents
without fraud or collusion then this obligation to be void and of none effect or else to remain in force
and to be in full force and power until or further more if the said Robert Pirrie from time to time
and at all times shall surrender up his said Body to the said Whittington as his prisoner as
occasion shall require which being duly performed the said Obligation to be void or else
to remain in force as is expressed before
