Counselors Morris and John Dickinson all of the County of Somerset agreed doo and justly stand
Indebted unto William Whittington Sheriff of the said County the sum of six thousand seven hundred
and ten pounds of tobacco and Liquid to be paid unto the said William Whittington his heirs Exors
and assigns which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves our heirs Exors
and assigns jointly and severally for and in the whole firmly by these presents and have hereunto affixed
our hands and seals the 11th day of August ann Dom 1696

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above Bounden Somersett Dickinson
is taken by Vertue of an Execution to pay unto Sam Wattling of the County of St Marys Sheriff of
the good and Chasties of John Special Dec for the quantity of one thousand three hundred pounds of
good sweet Fat West ports and five hundred pounds of Good a Cenns Debt Recovered in the
Provinciall Court as also the sum of six hundred twenty seven pounds of tobacco Charges arising in
the said Suit which by Computation amounteth to the sum of three thousand three hundred eighty
five pounds of tobacco now if the said Somersett Dickinson shall save keep harmless and indemnified

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
