 being the Gallanis of the aforesaid a^u wife Cate of *Sudo* alias *Excutio*.

 John Alexander was attached to answer unto William Parker of *Somerset* of the C^o of
 the D^y *Worthington* his attorney Complains that in
 the year of 1695 at *Locom* within the Jurisdiction of this Court, did take away &
 drive from the Plantation of *Jano* *Sangster* in *Locom* two *Acres* of the D^y *Wm* *Parker* being 200 at y^e plantation of
 the one of them six and the other seven years old, without the knowledge or consent of him the said William and unto
 what place it is unknown, It being the last time that he ever heard of the D^y *Wm* *Parker*. Now the D^y William in fact saith
 that by the D^y *John* driving of the Cattle away as afo^r that he hath lost them, & dammified to the value of three hundred
 pounds of lob^o and thereupon he brings the *Sudo* *Worthington* & of *pley* *the* *Rich^d*

And the D^y by *Rob^t Doul* his attorney defends his said injury & saith he is not guilty of the p^rincip^l imposed
 upon him, and that he prays may be enquired of by the Country Doul & D^y.
 And the p^t saith the D^y is guilty of what is declared ag^t him, and puts himself upon the Country his wife
Worthington.

The declaration being read the issue joyned as aforesaid Comand was by y^e *Wor^t* given that the Sheriff bring here
 twelve good & Lawfull Men of the County of *Wilt* that the matter in hand might be the better understood, List on
 names who were returned as follows. (viz) *Edward* *Good*, *Wm* *Sowth*, *Tho* *Cull* *Sund*, *Jm* *Porter*, *Jm* *Parson*,
John *White*, *Thom* *Stouffer*, *Wm* *Shanklin*, *Jacob* *Leby*, *Joan* *Spons*, *Rob^t* *Smith* & *Ned* *Whitting* 12
 who being legally summoned returned & sworn upon the holy Evangelists to try the said matter, having heard the
 p^rincip^l declaration p^ro & p^roc^ond, and also the evidence on both sides & upon the whole fairly examined, rec^ord
 their charges & doubt first in order to determine the same. And the day (viz) the day after the given afo^r Com^o into Court
 & being called over particularly being demanded are unanimously agreed of this Verdict the p^t D^y being called
 the Verdict is read in these express words following. *Wor^t* of the Jury find for the D^y *Edward* *Good* for man
 whose Verdict the Court Orders to be entered & confirmed the same, with all Costs to be recovered by y^e D^y ag^t y^e p^t the
