

Liberty of us the said Katherine and George, and after our decease give the said Farms to our Child
or Children of my husband George Johnson as shall be begotten on me the said Katherine his Wife
as shall be living at the time of his decease, as by the said Will bearing date the 24th day of March
anne Dom 1661

And further my virtuous Francis Butler aforesaid by his Last Will and Testament hath given unto me Katherine
Johnson aforesaid two acres, another farm which is in that said Will given to my Brother John Butler,
but hearing of my Brother John Butler's decease, then as aforesaid given to me the said Widow the aforesaid farm,
during my Natural life, and after my decease to my Child or Children as on me the said Katherine Johnson
by the said George Johnson Esq^r, or to be begotten or shall be living at my decease, and to their Heirs
assigns forever, which said farms lyeth in Groves in Wiltshire in the County of Kent aforesaid as doth
appear by a Schedule annexed to the said Will bearing date the 24th of October in the year of our Lord 1663

And for further Confirmation of the same, before whom this present Writing shall come, that I am
the Widow of my aforesaid virtuous Francis Butler formerly Wife to George Johnson Merchant aforesaid and now the Wife
of Thomas Dornden Lawfull Heir to the said Real & personall Estate given by his Will aforesaid

That my Father John and Katherine Butler his Wife, they lived at a place called Helling in the County of
Kent where the Subscriber Katherine Johnson alias Dornden was borne as said my Parents likewise my Father
and Mother had borne unto them three Children more vizt James, John, & Deborah Butler, and after my
Father's decease my Mother Katherine Butler married to one Peter Swan of Maidstone in the County of
Kent aforesaid

After the decease of my aforesaid Mother, my virtuous Francis Butler aforesaid, came to Maidstone & fetched me the
said Katherine the Subscriber and my Brother John and Deborah Butler home to his house at
Garston in the Parish of St James in the County of Kent aforesaid with whom my Brother James before
his death

34y I then Katherine Butler went to my virtuous Francis Butler aforesaid lived with my virtuous wife &
was twenty years of age, at which time was married to George Johnson Merchant at the Cathedral
aforesaid by John Player Minister and Pastor of a Congregation called Independents, afterwards lived
with my husband George Johnson in the Parish called St George the martire, and after removed
to the City of London where I lived several years, and had by my husband two Children one named
George and the other Katherine Johnson both borne in St George's Parish aforesaid

44y my husband George Johnson aforesaid trading by way of Merchandize into Virginia and the Province of
Maryland sent for me the said Katherine his Wife to come over to him to whom I went by the way
of New England to Somerset County in Maryland in the year of our Lord 1663 and brought with me
into the Province and County aforesaid my only daughter named Katherine Johnson and with my virtuous
Francis and John Butler his Wife to my only son George Johnson to be brought up, and my
said Katherine Butler alias Lee, put him the said George Johnson my son aforesaid a freedom apprentice
to a Watermaker in London

44y My daughter Katherine Johnson aforesaid married her with one John Goddin of Bogalstown hundred
in Somerset County in the Province of Maryland aforesaid the said Goddin having left two Children behind
her, the one named Katherine and the other Margaret Goddin which by the Last will & Testament
of my aforesaid virtuous Francis Butler are bequeathed with my son George Johnson aforesaid after the
decease of me the Subscriber and not before
