unto the said Andrew in the full sum of eleven hundred fifty three pounds of good
sound merchantable tobacco in and unto the said Cornelius according to the tenor of the said
Bill the afo quantity of tobacco both the said Andrew in his lifetime hath not paid nor to the said William
and Andrew nor to any of them, to the damage of the said William and Andrew tra of two thousand
pounds of like tobacco and thereupon they bring this Bill tra Whittington of 1687 to the said Court

The said bill bindeth the said Cornelius Anderson of the County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland Plaintiff
my heirs executors and assigns to pay or cause to be paid unto Andrew Whittington of the County of Somerset
afo Defendant his heirs executors assigns or assigns or assigns full attorney or Order the sum of eleven
hundred fifty three pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco in and unto the said Andrew
Whittington River upon or before the tenth day of October next ensuing the date hereof in which
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day of first June anno Domini 1687

of a Bill which he paid him of eight hundred pounds of tobacco bearing date
October 25th 1680 as witness my hand this first day of June anno 1687 the Whittington

And the Defendant by his attorney John Hausett hath pleaded eight hundred and
eighty five pounds for the Remainder of the Bill
And the Plaintiff saith that the whole Bill is due and puts himself upon the said Court
Whittington

And the Defendant in his proper person comes into Court and confesseth the Debt in the Declaration a-
bove to be just and true and is considered by the Court here that the said William Hausett and
tra recover against the Defendant as well the sum of eleven hundred fifty three pounds of good
sound merchantable tobacco in and unto the said Cornelius as also the sum of
pounds of tobacco for his cost of suit in his behalf lay out and expended and the Debt
in mercy

Roger Furber Esqr. fined for not attending the Court the Court vizt/ fifty pounds tobacco which
fine the same day was remitted

Court adjourned for half a hour
