On behalf of the above named Eigne Riggins I the said Samuel Worthington of the Justices
 on the Bench were in Sam. Johnson in George England and Ed. Roberts and in Edmund
 Howard

And the Defendant in proper person comes into Court and confesses the debt in the Declaration
 above mentioned to be just and true and so it is considered by the Court here that the said Eigne
 Riggins recover against the Defendant as well the sum of seven thousand two hundred pounds
 pounds of Tobacco in the Declaration mentioned as also the sum of three hundred and sixteen
 pounds of Tobacco for the cost of suit in the behalf said out expenses of £12 in money
