 & gallon wine amount in the whole to the sum of four hundred & ten pounds of tobacco, which for
 the day they are damaged & shall be to the value of five thousand pounds of tobacco & the day being
 then into the
 Court of Quind. Pledge the... Ricke.

And the said James & the said Attorney General & the said Sir John Dinecourt that the
 said Declaration ought not to be allowed, by reason that he never made any agreement with the said jointly
 but it was severally that they have past their Bill severally since that Walter Taylor had these sums
 of Cash & past his Bill for the same before they have laid in their Declaration that they made their agreement
 with the said James, Sir Richard Cull and the sum of Barrels before the date aforesaid and for the reason aforesaid
 advised of the Court, of that he quitted himself upon the Court. Worthington pro def.

 with in the Jurisdiction of the Court by his certain Bill Obligatory which the said Thomas with the Seal of the
 Michael signed brought into Court the date whereof is the day & year aforesaid and acknowledged himself to be indebted
 unto the said Thomas in the sum of one hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable bright tobacco in
 Cash clear of all manner of trash to be paid to the said Thomas Complainant in St. Maries County at or upon the tenth
 day of October next following with shrewdly to be made the said Michael bound himself firmly by his Bill
 the tenth day of the said Michael the same to the said Thomas in the sum of one hundred pounds the date of the said
 Thomas now to either of them the said date not paid but the said date to pass & yet still refuse to the damage of the
 said Thomas about a fourth of 3000 pounds of tobacco and thereon he brings his bills the
 Court of Quind. Pledge the... Ricke.

And he has brought into Court a Certificate of the latter Courtmentary whereby it may appear to the
 Court how the said Thomas has been bound of the said Francis Deul to the said...

Now all Men of these parts that Michael Murphy of Maryd County do acknowledge my self to be justly indebted
 to Francis Deul of the same County in the full & just sum of six hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable
 bright tobacco in Cash clear of all manner of trash, to be paid to the said Francis Deul his Heir & Assigns or
 Assigns at or upon the tenth day of October Comenient in St. Maries County, to the which payment, with shrewdly to be made
 binds my self my Heir & Assigns firmly by these words. In witness whereof I have subscribed with my hand
