action of the Case and did whereupon the said George by Edward Jend his Attorney
and I say that the said John in the year of our Lord 1693 then became indebted

wherein the sum of six hundred pounds of Tobacco the said John did promise & assumed to pay to the said George when the same
required, but the said John not minding his promise & assumption but fraudulently intended the said sum to be in the
sum of six hundred pounds of Tobacco, although of the said sum he is indebted, which upon the said plea he is damaged and
