

And the Petitioner sheweth that it was for one fourth part of 2000 pounds of Tobacco for work done, & will make appear by Evidence that George Part's debt is an act of 2000 pound Tobacco that was gotten by the work done aforesaid and paid him 2000^l Tobacco which was the same part that he put to him, of his own himself upon the Court.

And the Defendant saith that he sought to know to whom the work was done & at what time he put himself on the Court also. And the Petitioner saith he was but servant to the said George, and that he kept the account of what work was done, and that was had from him, which will prove and put himself upon the Court also. *Worthington.*

Archibald Holmes Cooper was attached to answer unto Henry Hudson Junr of a Debt of 200^l Tobacco. And whereas upon this the said Henry Hudson Junr the Attorney comes & saith that he is Archibald on the 10th day of December in the year of our Lord 1689 at Pocomsoc within the Jurisdiction of the Court by a certain Bill Obligatory became indebted unto the said Henry in the just sum of Eight hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco in Cash to be paid on demand at some convenient Landing in Accomack, the date of this Bill being the day of your aft. Moreover he saith that the said sum of Tobacco according to the tenor of this Bill is the said Henry hath not paid to the damage of the said Henry of Eight hundred pounds of like Tobacco. And hereupon he brings his own Bill.

This Bill binds me Archibald Holmes Wind Cooper in Demorsete County in the Province of Maryland in my self my Heirs Executors and assigns to pay or cause to be paid unto Henry Hudson Junr Planter County afo. Colonial his Heirs Executors or Assignes the full and just sum of Eight hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable Tobacco in Cash according to the tenor of the said Bill to be paid on demand at some convenient Landing in Accomack Quarter County afo. for the true performance of the said I have hereunto put my hand & seal this 10th day of December. One thousand six hundred Eighty nine 1689.
