Notwithstanding the said John the aforesaid quantity of Tobacco unto the said Sylas hath not paid although the same was requested but hath hitherto refused and doth still refuse to the damage of the said Sylas of 2000 pounds of Tobacco & thereof he bringeth this Sub^a.

Richard Tull late of Somers County Gentleman was summoned to answer unto Henry Schelfield of a Plea that he should owe unto him the full & just sum of three thousand pounds of York shire to him the said Henry Schelfield & family the said Henry by his Attorney saith that whereas the said Richard the 10th day of January in the year of our Lord 1694 at Decemb^r within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said Henry in the said full & just sum of 3000 pounds of York shire as may appear by the certain Bill Obligatory which the said Henry with the seal of the said Richard signed & brought into Court, the date whereof is the day & year aforesaid to be paid to the said Henry Schelfield at or upon the last day of November next ensuing the date of the said Bill, notwithstanding the said Richard the said sum of 3000 pounds of York shire he hath not paid to the damage of the said Henry of 6000 pounds of York shire and thereof he bringeth this Sub^a.

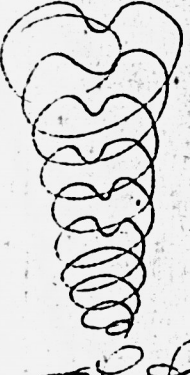
