Wm Bredmy, Hon Hudson, Robert Smith, John Forster, Henry Forster, Wm Bowen, 12. who being legally  
summed returned & sworn upon the holy Evangelists, who having fairly heard the Evidence Examination  
on their Oath, returned their Charge and Seal for in order to determine the matter in  
and this day (viz) the day of year after the aforesaid Jurors of the aforesaid between the said Mary & the  
Mary Hall do make their return into Court, being duly man & firmly called & demanded if agreed,  
where day they are unanimously agreed of their Verdict, the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>d</sup> being called the Verdict is read as  
followeth (viz) W<sup>o</sup> of the Jury find for the 1<sup>st</sup>. John Turnish foreman.

Which Verdict the Court ordered to be entered, and further ordered that the Sheriff take into Custody the Body  
of the said Mary for her Crime Comitted to give her fifteen lashes on her bare back at 4 Whipping  
post well laid on. which was by the Sheriff Executed as of his return in.
