The fore Bond & Deposition being read the Evidence sworn & examined, It did appear to the Court that the said Knox had misbehaved himself to the said Anne, as well as abused authoritatively, for which the said Court did order, as it is here by Order that the said James Knox be fined five hundred pounds of Tobacco and that the same be paid to the use of the Poor of this County, and that the said James give good security for his behavior for one year, whereupon came the said James and his Securities John Mackint & John Knox and the said James did acknowledge and confess himself to be indebted unto our Sovereign Lord the King the sum of twenty pounds Sterling money, & the said John Mackint & John Knox in the sum of seven pounds a piece the money aforesaid, all due to be levied on their Lands & Chattels goods & Chattels for the Malice use &c.

The Condition of which Recognizance is such that if the above James Knox do pay the fine aforesaid also be of the good behaviour and abstinence to all his Masters good People of this Province during the Courts pleasure then the Recognizance to be void & of no effect other way to be & remain in full power force and Virtue. //
