Arnold Eby have agreed in Open Court according to his intent & meaning there of

John Maglaughlin, son of Daniel, was this day by consent of his Mother, by the Worth Court bound apprentice to Thomas Carr Coop^r, & to Carr Coop^r promises to learn him his & do work to wad, and at the expiration of his time (viz) 21 years to give him a set of Coopers tools. the said John being four years old the 25th day of January next /
