At Wincemore within the Jurisdiction of this Court, he did deliver into the Custody of the said William Starye these goodds following (viz) One feather Bed & Bonifter, One Kuyge & one pair of white Blanketts, One Iron Wedge, four pewter dishes, one pewter Cantare, one frying pan, One narrow ch. One Grid Iron, One Brass pan white the said William did promise to deliver unto the said John when he should demand them. Notwithstanding the said William his promise not regarding, but fraudulently & craftily intending him the said John of the aforesaid goodds to deprive, & did deny to deliver them to the aforesaid John according to his promise, but unjustly detaine them to the damage of the said John of seven hundred pounds of tobacco & thereupon he brings this suite. And if Plaintiff saith that he never sold the goodds he hath declared for, dicit of this party himself upon the Court Worthington. *an an an an an*  
 The promise aforesaid being left to the judgment of this Court, who having considered the same, do find in favor of the Plaintiff and therefore do order a Non Suite against the Defendant & Costs Executed

Geoffrey Sumnerford a Melbore Boy was this day brought into Court by Mr Thomas Boynter Junior. The said Boynter on oath made appear that the said Geoffrey had unlawfully absented himself & run away from him twenty eight days, and that he the said Boynter like wife made appear that he had paid six hundred pounds of tobacco & cost of 700 to run away. It like wife further appeared to this Court that the said Boynter had sold the said Geoffrey with his run away time & tobacco aforesaid to Mr James Round who humbly prayed Order for 700 to run away time, and also what service for 700 six hundred pounds of tobacco aforesaid. Where being considered it by this Court Ordered that the said Geoffrey Sumnerford do serve the said Round two hundred & eighty days for his run away time aforesaid, and one whole year for the six hundred pounds of tobacco by the said Boynter expended.

John Stranbrooke p. Contra: Adm. of And. Whittington d. } Saisi facias against the said defendant being made known for 2640 pounds of tobacco with cost on a judgment formerly obtained (viz) 15<sup>th</sup> of August and being 1690. against the said Whittington. The said Attorney made app<sup>r</sup> in Court that eight hundred pounds of the aforesaid was paid. which being considered, this Court confirmed the former judgment and gave Order against the said Whittington for the balance (viz) for eight hundred & fourty six pounds with cost ahead Executed.
