delivered unto the said John at the Plantation of Charles Hall for work done by the said John to the said Thomas  
and the said Thomas being indebted as aforesaid did give unto the said John a bill of exchange for the said  
quantity of Syder as aforesaid with trusty content & pay. Moreover the said Thomas his  
promise and assumption not regarding but minding of fraudulently intending the plt to describe in the  
said quantity of 30 gallons of Syder as aforesaid although of better nature unto required but hath refused to pay  
and still doth refuse whereupon the plt saith he is damaged & hath lost to the value of six hundred  
pounds of tobacco and thereupon brings his Sute. & Quod Edward Jones

the action aforesaid ought not to have, for that the plt hath not laid the action to be  
within the Jurisdiction of this Court, neither hath he put in pledge for prosecution of

David Browne, in a plea of debt.

And whereupon the said David Browne by Edward Jones his Attorney saith that the said John upon  
the fifth day of February in the year of Lord 1694 became indebted to the said David Browne in the sum  
of two thousand six hundred sixty eight pounds of tobacco as doth more plainly appear by his  
Bill Obligatory by his Bill under the hand & seal of the said John & that in Court presented  
the Condition of the said obligation is such that if the said John would well & truly pay or cause to be  
paid to the said David Browne his Heirs Executors or Assignes the just quantity of tobacco  
three hundred thirty eight pounds of tobacco to the said David Browne, then the obligation to be void and of no effect, and  
the said John being indebted as aforesaid, not regarding but minding of fraudulently intending  
the plt to describe in the sum of 2668 pounds of tobacco, but hath neglected to pay & still doth neglect  
whereupon the plt saith he is damaged & hath lost to the value of 3000 pounds of tobacco & there  
upon brings his Sute & Quod Edward Jones.
