pay two year Tax to the Lord of this County (viz) for 7 year 1693 & 1694

Know all Men by these presents that Wm William Whittington, Esquire Sheriff and Sam Worthington of the County of
Somerset in the Province of Maryland Gent^l; do owe and are indebted unto our Sovereign Lord King William the
third to his Honor the Sheriff, the just sum of three hundred the said pound of Tobacco good & Merchantable
which was promised to pay to his said Majesty for and for the true performance of the same, Wm Bind and
Carg of us our Honor & Honor jointly & severally in and for the whole. In testimony whereof was past
his unto both our hands & seals this 11th day of August in the eighth year of his said Majesty King
England the 11th day of August 1696.

THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Whittington do well and lawfully
serve his said Majesty King William the third his Honor and Successors in the place & Office of High Sheriff of
Somerset County during his Commission, and shall also render & pay unto his said Majesty the said Sheriff and
perfect account of all Rents fines and other sums due and payable to his said Majesty his Honor & Successors
and also shall render & pay unto all his Majesty's Officers and others all such sums of Tobacco as he shall receive
from time to time or other sums of money for the said duties shall be by the said Officers or others intrusted to receive
and shall likewise in all things & matters whatsoever relating to the place & Office of High Sheriff well and
faithfully behave himself towards his said Majesty and all the good People of this County in that he shall
obligation to be void & of none effect, other ways to be and remain, in full power force & Virtue.
