Ordered by the Wor. Court that process issue forth on this and the present Grand Jury is dissolved

Whereas Robert Vigeroud being fourteen year of age next August was by his first consent and approbation by his Mother, was put apprentice by the Court to Robert Howlston till one and twenty years of age, and Howlston to take into his Custodie one Cow and her calf with a two year old Heifer of 7 to Vigeroud's, and the same to keep until the next day to him the said Howlston. But at the expiration of the 21. year of age the said Howlston do deliver to the said Vigeroud the like number of Cattle in specie as he recd with one Cow & Calf more. Ordered that the Howlston give security to affirm and observe to be born to Vigeroud to read. Whereas upon Cause the said Robert Howlston & his brother John Howlston and by Recognizance did confess themselves to owe and be indebted unto the said Robert Vigeroud the sum of ten pounds sterling money due to be paid out their goods for 7 to Vigeroud up to the Condition of which Recognizance is that if the said Robert Howlston do deliver to the said Vigeroud aforesaid two Cows and Calves with one two year old Heifer when the said Vigeroud shall attain to the age of 21 years and also to bear him to read then the Recognizance to be void of none effect otherwise to be remain in full power force & virtue.
