His Matie Contra } The d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1693. was found for swearing ones  
Wm. Lawrence def. } Catted, which d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> was this day confirmed & ordered by this Court  
that he sh<sup>o</sup>ld pay ad his ffines twenty four pounds of tobacco & of al<sup>l</sup> ex<sup>ecutio</sup>.

His Matie Contra } The d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 1694. being found according to  
John Pope def. } del. of Assembly for breach of sabbate, where d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> was this day by  
W<sup>or</sup> Justices in Court confirmed & to John Crooked to pay for d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup>  
one hundred pounds of tobacco with Cost<sup>s</sup> alias ex<sup>ecutio</sup>.

John Pope defend } found one hundred pounds of tobacco for refusing to aid & assist

& ordered to John pay 100. tobacco with Cost<sup>s</sup> alias ex<sup>ecutio</sup>.

His Matie Contra } The d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> y<sup>e</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> of Aug<sup>ust</sup> 1695 was found for drunkenness & swearing

that satisfaction was made by the d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> John for the ffines afo<sup>r</sup>, by work

Sam Worthington his Attorney Complaineth that the d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> William in the year of our Lord 1692 at  
Pacowes within the Jurisdiction of this Court became indebted unto the d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> Slepton in his  
life time in the just sum of three hundred fifty five pounds of tobacco it being for County and  
County levies, whereof the said William had afores<sup>d</sup> sum of tobacco to the d<sup>e</sup>ff<sup>er</sup> Slepton in
